What can go in the Food Waste Caddy?



- ✓ Meat, poultry, fish and bones
- ✓ Leftover food and plate scrapings
- ✓ Fruit and vegetable peelings
- ✓ Gone off fruit and vegetables
- ✓ Tea bags, coffee grounds and paper filters
- ✓ Bread, cakes, biscuits

- ✓ Rice, pasta and cereals
- ✓ Diary products such as cheese, butter and yogurts
- ✓ Soups and sauces
- ✓ Eggs and eggshells
- ✓ Soiled paper napkins and kitchen roll
- ✓ Small amounts of newspapers if used to wrap food
- ✓ Any out of date foods– remember to remove the packaging
